**Subject: Intervention codes for the implementation dimension introduced in
SFC2021 for Home Affairs Funds programmes for the period 2021-2027**

Dear Members of the Committee for the Home Affairs Funds,

The main purpose of this note is to clarify the structure of **codes for the implementation dimension** currently available in **SFC2021** in order to assist the authorities with appropriate encoding of the relevant data. The overview of this structure for all three Home Affairs Funds is provided in **Annex I** to this note.

Concerning the relevant legal framework, the codes for the implementation dimension are listed in **Table 3 of Annex VI of the Fund-specific Regulations** ⁽¹⁾. For the AMIF and the BMVI, these lists are being amended through Article 81 of the Asylum and Migration Management Regulation ⁽²⁾ and Article 9 of the Return Border Procedure Regulation ⁽³⁾, respectively. Since these (already entered into force) Regulations will enter into application on 12 June 2026, as from that date, there will be full correspondence

between the codes currently available in SFC2021 and the codes in the AMIF and BMVI Regulations (as amended).

In addition, the Commission introduced in SFC2021 a specific separate entry (code 010) for the **Pact (and Ukraine) Specific Action** available under all specific objectives of the AMIF programmes and the specific objective 1 of the BMVI programmes. This entry/code does not introduce a new implementation dimension (type of action) per se but only concerns the structure of SFC2021 in order to enable separate encoding of data on this particular specific action for monitoring and reporting purposes ⁽⁴⁾.

With regard to the use of the above codes under different modules and reporting structures in SFC2021, the authorities are reminded of the following:

The codes for the implementation dimension and the specific entry/code for the Pact (and Ukraine) specific action allow to encode the corresponding amounts in separate lines in the **financial plan** (Table 6) of the programme. The same structure is also introduced in the modules for **payment applications** and **accounts** in SFC2021, as these mirror the structure of the financial plan of the programme.

Concerning **Table 3** of the module for **transmission of financial data** in SFC2021:

- Column 2 contains the co-financing rate indicated in the financial plan (Table 6) of the programme for the given implementation dimension or the Pact (and Ukraine) specific action. This information is automatically sourced from Table 6 of the programme.
- Column 5 should refer to the code of the implementation dimension (or the code for the Pact (and Ukraine) specific action) in order to be coherent with the financial plan (Table 6) of the programme.

The codes become available in the module for transmission of data only once they are introduced in a given programme (i.e. added to the financial plan (Table 6) of the programme). When encoding the relevant data in SFC2021, each code number is accompanied by its descriptive name to facilitate identification of the appropriate code to be selected.

Moreover, please note also that as for the implementation dimension '**Solidarity Actions**' created for the implementation of the solidarity mechanism under the Pact on Migration and Asylum, the corresponding new codes were introduced in SFC2021 also for the **intervention field dimension** (Table 1 of Annex VI of the Fund-specific Regulations), in line with the relevant above-mentioned legal basis ⁽⁵⁾:

- Code '007 Solidarity Actions' under the AMIF specific objective 4
- Code '030 Solidarity Actions' under the BMVI specific objective 1

These two codes need to be reflected, where relevant ⁽⁶⁾, in Table 3 of the programmes (Indicative breakdown of the programme resources (EU) by type of intervention) as well as in column 3 of Table 3 for the transmission of financial data.

In addition, please be informed that with regard to the AMIF and the structure of the **pledging plan** (Table 6A of the programme), two new categories are being introduced in SFC2021 ⁽⁷⁾, based on Article 14 (2) of the Union Resettlement and Humanitarian Admission Framework Regulation ⁽⁸⁾ amending Article 19 of the AMIF Regulation and introducing the ‘national resettlement schemes’. These two new categories are as follows:

- ‘National resettlement schemes in line with Article 19 (2) of the AMIF Regulation
- ‘National resettlement schemes - vulnerable in line with Article 19 (3) of the AMIF Regulation

These two categories affect the structure of Table 6A only. As for the financial plan (Table 6) of the programme, they both form a part of the implementation dimension (type of action) ‘Resettlement and humanitarian admission’.
